CAMP LEAKEY – FACES IN THE FOREST | 10 Days: 25 October to 4 November 2013

Bali, Indonesia

Your cruise departs from the Indonesian island of Bali where there are beautiful beaches, a rich culture incorporating art, music, dance and craft-making, as well as stunning countryside covered with rice fields, volcanic peaks and lush rainforest.

Day At Sea

You will spend today sailing, giving you the opportunity to take in the lovely seascapes as you travel to the island of Borneo.

Two Days in Tanjung Puting National Park, Kalimantan, Borneo, Indonesia

You will visit Tanjung Puting National Park in the Indonesian region of Borneo. Tanjung Puting is a spectacular natural wonder and two days will be spent here (with one night on-board the ship) to make the most of all that it has to offer. Most notably, the park is renowned for its primates, including orangutans and the Proboscis Monkey, which has a rather large and distinctive nose. However, the park also has over two-hundred species of birds which live in the forests and wetlands and include Hornbills and White Egrets. The park is also home to Camp Leakey Research Station where Orangutan Foundation International is based. During your time in Tanjung Puting National Park, you will be able to enjoy a boat trip to explore the river and

waterways around Camp Leakey, where you'll have the privilege of observing feeding stations that have been set up for the orangutans, enabling you to enjoy an incredible viewing experience. You can also visit Orangutan Foundation International's Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre and observe the forest training area, 'pre-school' and the infant care facility for the orphaned orangutans.

Two days at sea

Two Days in Kuching, Sarawak, Borneo, Malaysia

On your first day, you will discover the vibrant city of Kuching, the largest in Borneo, on an afternoon city tour. Highlights of this tour include Sarawak's oldest temple, Astana (the former palace of the White Rajah), the old Colonial Law Courts, old Malay-style stilted houses and Sarawak Museum. In the evening, you will enjoy a cultural performance and a Malay-style banquet before re-boarding the ship to spend the night, ready for a second day in Kuching. Kuching is also the gateway to Semenggoh Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre where work is undertaken to care for orangutans and other animals.

Bako National Park, Sarawak, Borneo, Malaysia

You will arrive early to take full advantage of exploring the rainforests of Bako National Park. The stunning

scenery incorporates tumbling waterfalls, streams and remote beaches, with an array of plant and birdlife. A number of walks, with varying degrees of difficulty, will allow you to experience the park's different ecosystems and look for wildlife, including a variety of birds and primates, such as Proboscis and Macaques Monkeys.

Natuna Archipelago, Indonesia

The Natuna Islands – located in the Natuna Sea, between Peninsular Malaysia and Borneo – are relatively remote and the landscape is one that is dotted with volcanic peaks and edged with pristine white-sand beaches. During your visit, you will learn more about the local community and, weather permitting, have the opportunity to explore the reefs on a guided snorkelling safari.

Anambas Archipelago, Indonesia

The Anambas Archipelago is virtually uninhabited and the waters surrounding them are rich with opportunities to enjoy the coral reefs and the marine life that they support. Your visit here will include a delicious beach barbecue on a secluded beach.

Singapore

Arrive into Singapore, a splendid fast-paced city full of contrasts and a delightful blend of Chinese, Malay and Indian cultures.
